The table below shows the percentage of pupils who reached the level expected for their age at the end of KS2 and the percentage of those who reached the 'higher standard'.

The second table shows the average scaled test score of pupils last year where 100 is National average and 110 is the 'higher standard'.

The final table shows the average progress made by children in Year 6 last year from KS1 to KS2 where zero is National average.
