How did water shape Sheffield?

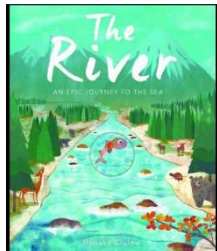
This term our learning will focus on **Science** as we learn about how water can be shown as the different stages of matter as a solid, a liquid and a gas. The children will also be learning about the different stages of the water cycle and the features of rivers in **Geography**. In **History** the children will be learning how water was really important to power machinery in the industrial revolution through the use of a water wheel. They will visit the Shepherd's Wheel in Sheffield to see this in action. We will also be developing our **Art** skills of painting and sewing and using these to create a landscape picture inspired by water.

Literacy

Our key texts this term are:



The children will be re-telling the story of Perfectly Norman and they will be writing their own information sheet all about solids, liquids and gases. Later in the term, they will be writing a setting description of a landscape with a river.

Maths

This term we focus on place value and will be partitioning, ordering, comparing and reading and writing 3d numbers. We will also be working on adding and subtracting 1, 10 and 100 to 3d numbers. Later in the term, we will be developing the children's skills of mental and formal column methods for addition and subtraction. We will also be practicing our times tables regularly starting with the 10x, 5x, 2x and 3x.

Computing

We will be learning about online safety and reminding the children about how to use ICT equipment in a sensible way. Later in the term, the children will be learning how to make their own videos. This will include using skills like taking photographs, recording videos, recording sound and editing a finished product.

Religious Education

In the first half term the children will be focusing on the Jewish festival of Passover and learning how it is celebrated with a cedar plate. Later in the term, the children will be looking at the Nativity story and why Mary was chosen to be the mother of Jesus.
